Treasury Wine Estates Most Successful At Royal Queensland Wine Show

Friday 8th July 2011

Treasury Wine Estates kicked off the national wine show circuit with an outstanding eight trophies and 21 gold medals, including The Courier-Mail Trophy for Champion Wine of Show for the 2005 Seppelt Drumborg Riesling and a special highlight, The Dan O'Conner Trophy to Treasury Wine Estates for Most Successful Exhibitor.

Chris Hatcher, Chief Winemaker Treasury Wine Estates is delighted with the results: "To kick off the capital city wine show circuit with a run like this, not just for the individual wines but for the winemaking team as a whole, is outstanding. It's fitting recognition for the whole Treasury Wine Estates team."

Seppelt Drumborg Riesling 2005 was a star of the show, taking home three trophies including Champion Wine of Show. The Seppelt Drumborg Vineyard in southern Victoria experiences challenging weather conditions and does not deliver every year, but when it does, the results are outstanding.

Rosemount was another successful entrant taking home five gold medals while Penfolds shone with its chardonnay offerings, receiving two trophies for the Penfolds Thomas Hyland Chardonnay from 2010 and one for the Penfolds Reserve Bin A Chardonnay 2008.

The Royal Queensland Wine Show is one of Australia's oldest, most prestigious and highly contested wine shows. As the first national wine show held in capital cities across Australia, this show allows Australia's best wine producers to reveal their new season's vintage.

A total of 12 judges and four associate judges from across Australia are divided into four panels to judge wines over a period of five days.
