Trophy win for Treasury Wine Estates at International Wine & Spirits Competition

Treasury Wine Estates (TWE) success at the world's leading wine shows continues, receiving 1 Trophy and 53 medals, including 5 Gold at the International Wine & Spirits Competition (IWSC) in the UK this week.

The International Wine & Spirits Competition Trophy for Shiraz was awarded to the 2002 Saltram No. 1 Barossa Valley Shiraz.

Chris Hatcher, Treasury Wine Estates Chief Winemaker was delighted with the results: "With entries from over 82 countries around the world, it is honour to have achieved such outstanding results at the IWSC. I commend the tremendous effort by the respective winemaking teams at Treasury Wine Estates".

5 Gold medals were awarded to the following wines:

- 2002 Saltram No. 1 Barossa Valley Shiraz
- 2008 Penfolds RWT Barossa Valley Shiraz
- 2004 Wolf Blass Platinum Label Barossa Shiraz
- 2007 Wolf Blass Platinum Label Barossa Shiraz
- 2008 Penfolds Yattarna Chardonnay

In addition to the Gold medals a further 48 medals were awarded to Treasury Wine Estates across Lindeman's, Matua Valley, Penfolds, Rosemount Estate, Saltram, Squealing Pig, Wolf Blass and Wynns.

About the International Wine & Spirits Competition:

The International Wine and Spirit Competition was founded in 1969 and is the premier competition of its kind in the world. Its aim is to promote the quality and excellence of the world's best wines, spirits and liqueurs.

This standard is achieved through a rigorous two-stage judging process of professional blind tasting and detailed technical (chemical and microbiological) analysis that takes place at The Competition's headquarters in Surrey, UK. To ensure perfect conditions, the premises include temperature-controlled cellars, a fully equipped independent laboratory for technical analysis, and three dedicated tasting rooms.

The Competition has the support of many of the world's top wine and spirits producers and received entries from over 82 countries worldwide.
