Treasury Wine Estates and Annie's Lane dominate 2012 Royal Queensland Wine Show

Treasury Wine Estates needs a new trophy cabinet after the 2012 Royal Queensland Wine Show winning six trophies and 31 Gold Medals. Annie's Lane, Coppertrail Shiraz 2010, was the star of the show winning three trophies including:

The Alan Cook MBE Trophy for Best Gold Medal winning Mature Red Wine Two Years and older in Classes 30 to 38

The Brisbane Club Trophy for the Best Gold Medal winning Dry Red Shiraz Wine in Mature Class 32

The Courier-Mail Trophy for the Grand Champion Wine of Show selected from all Trophy winning wines, excluding Current Vintage Whites, One Year Old Reds and Fortified Wines.

Annie's Lane Chief Winemaker, Alex MacKenzie, said he was pleased that Clare Valley Shiraz and Annie's Lane had been recognised at such an important wine show.

"You're out in the vineyard, tasting the flavours of the grapes and wondering how the wine from them will turn out. I'm absolutely thrilled and pretty humbled that we've gotten the show's top trophy," said Alex.

"The Annie's Lane Coppertrail Shiraz is sourced 100% from mature Clare Valley vineyards and is only released in the better years. The 2010 reflects the fantastic vintage we had. It is sourced from the two Clare Valley sub regions of Sevenhill and Armagh."

The Annie's Lane Coppertrail Shiraz 2010 is extremely limited in volume and will be released in August with a Recommended Retail Price of \$69.99.

Another major win in the Show for TWE was Rosemount Estate's most successful exhibitor trophy, a result of Rosemount Estate's wines receiving the highest number of points in Wine and Brandy Classes, totalling nine gold medals.
