Treasury Wine Estates shines at Perth Royal Wine Show

Wines from the Treasury Wine Estates (TWE) portfolio wowed palates at the recent Royal Perth Wine Show, collecting 121 awards overall, including the trophy for Most Successful Exhibitor for Rosemount Estate.

TWE was awarded eight Trophies and 27 Gold Medals in the show, with judges selecting the 2012 Rosemount Estate Flagships McLaren Vale Shiraz Cabernet (1 February 2014 release), 2012 Penfolds Bin A Chardonnay, 2012 Coldstream Hills Esplanade Pinot Noir, 2010 Rosemount Estate Little Berry Shiraz and the 2009 Coldstream Hills Chardonnay Pinot Noir Sparkling as particular standouts.

Chief Executive Officer David Dearie was thrilled with the result, noting the large number of brands within the TWE portfolio that received recognition.

“I’m always impressed at how many of our brands consistently stand out at wine shows both in Australia and internationally, and the Perth Royal Show is no exception with 21 different Treasury brands receiving awards. This is a big chunk of our portfolio and really demonstrates our dedication to quality and continuing excellence,” he said.

Established more than 40 years ago by the Royal Agricultural Society of Western Australia, the Royal Perth Wine Show is Western Australia’s premier wine competition benchmarking local, interstate and overseas wines.
